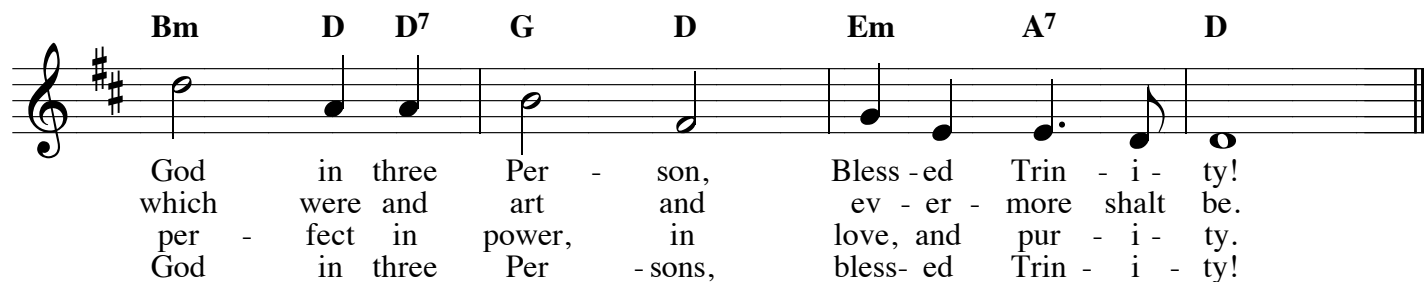
Ear-ly in the morn-ing our song shall rise to thee.
